REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS- RFQ/FEB2018/003

FOR RATIONALIZATION AND MERGING OF EXISTING QUALIFICATION PACKS/NATIONAL OCCUPATIONAL STANDARDS

February 20, 2018

1. Scope of Work

CGSC has identified 5 Qualification Packs which need to be rationalized to form a new QP.

The agency conducting rationalization would be required to

1. Carry out a market scan and demand forecast both in short term and long term for the new merged QP.
2. Recommend any deletion or addition of QPs from the 5 identified QPs post the market scan and demand forecast.
3. Identify any regulatory or statutory requirement applicable for the revised / merged QP.
4. Develop a new rationalized QP by merging identified 5 existing QP / based on recommendations as per serial 2 above, as per NSDC QRC/NSQC guidelines.
5. Conduct industry validation of the merged QP and developing the Q Files to support in QRC and NSQC approval.
6. Suggest necessary changes /update in the existing Occupational Map based on serial 1 and 2 above

3. General Instructions

- The firms / agencies may send Quotation as Individual, Firm/s or Consortia, giving out the details of the partnership model.
- Must have a Permanent Account Number (PAN) from Income Tax authorities.
- All the communication to CGSC including the Quotation shall be signed by the authorized representative of the Firm / Agency / Consortia on letter head
- Information which is considers proprietary, should be clearly marked "proprietary" next to the relevant part of the text and it will then be treated as such accordingly.
- The final selection and agreement with the shortlisted agency will be as per CGSC guidelines.

4. Rights of CGSC

- At any time, CGSC may, for any reason, change the last date/timelines of RFQ.
- The amendment will be intimated to all proposers who confirm their intention to participate, by email.
- CGSC may cancel the RFQ at any time without assigning any reason.
- CGSC may ask for fresh RFQ if found necessary.
- CGSC makes no commitments, express or implied, that this process will result in a business transaction with anyone.
- CGSC reserves the right to accept or reject any Quotation, and to annul the short listing process and reject all responses at any time without thereby incurring any liability or any obligation to inform the affected parties of the grounds for CGSC's action.

5. Guidelines for submitting Quotation

The firms / agencies are required to email Quotation on letter head to undertake the job of rationalization as mentioned above. The Quotation should include the following:

- Brief Company Profile including Nature of Business, years of Operation, registration, PAN/TAN/GST etc.
- Brief Details of prior experience if any in similar project in India or abroad.
- Details of offices and operational connect in states and regions
- Details of the contact person
- Approach & Methodology
- Deliverables with Timelines
- Quote including taxes
